Loy Lake 12-Inch Water Line (Loy Lake Rd. to F.M. 691)

PROJECT OVERVIEW Capital Improvement Planning included a new computerized water distribution system model, which yielded the need for more water supply to support continued growth at FM 691 and US 75. The selected route for a new 12-inch water line is the abandoned MKT Sherman-Denison Railroad (RR) right-of-way (ROW), and three-quarters of the needed route have been purchased. Design work began in October, 2017 and construction is scheduled for spring through winter 2018. It is planned for the City is to someday also make use of the same RR ROW as a connecting hike and bike trail between FM 691 and Waterloo Regional Park.
