

PUBLIC NOTICE
Ordinance Number 4452

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENISON, TEXAS. PROVIDING FOR THE ELECTION OF COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 4 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAID CITY, AND DESIGNATING THE DAY AND TIME OF THE ELECTION, AND THE POLLING PLACE; AND ORDAINING OTHER MATTERS ON THE SUBJECT, AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE WAS PASSED WAS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a special election shall be held in and throughout the City of Denison, Texas, on Saturday, the 10th day of May, 2008, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purposes of electing the following officers of said city:

COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 4 (Single Member District 4, Place 4)

SECTION 2. That , as provided in Section 2.01 of the Denison City Charter, as amended on January 19, 1985, the term of office for the Council Member to be elected to Place 4 shall be for three (3) years.

SECTION 3. That the candidates for Place 4 shall be residents of Single Member District Four. The candidates for Place 4 shall be residents of the City of Denison and shall be elected by a majority vote of the residents of Single Member District 4.

SECTION 4: That said election shall be held in each of the Single Member District 4 only , within said city of Denison, Texas, and the polling place for Single Member District 4 as follows, to-wit:

DISTRICT	POLLING PLACE
Single Member District 4	West End Fire Station 2720 West Morton

SECTION 5: That the first day to file an application for place on ballot for said election shall be April 3, 2008, and the last day to file an application for place on the ballot shall be April 9, 2008.

SECTION 6: That it is hereby ordered that early voting shall begin on April 28, 2008, and continue through May 6, 2008, at Denison City Hall at 500 West Chestnut Street, Denison, Texas, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 5:00 o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday. In addition, on Wednesday April 30, 2008 and Thursday, May 1, 2008, the hours of early voting shall be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and to be conducted otherwise pursuant to the requirements of the Texas Election Code. The early voting clerk for said election shall be Julie Lollar, Intermin City Clerk, and Dorothy Strain, Nancy Cockrell and Don Strain, deputy early voting clerks, each of which is hereby appointed.

SECTION 7: That voting at said election shall be by use of an electronic voting machine and the City Council does determine hereby that the electronic voting machine shall be used for the casting of early votes at this election. Ballots requested by mail shall be paper ballots that will be tabulated by hand in the manner required by the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 8: The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the election hereby authorized and called in the manner and time as required by the Election Code of the State of Texas.

SECTION 9: It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Article 551.041, Texas Government Code.

AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
