***** TRIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM *****

The Denison City Council has authorized a trial solid waste recycling program to assess the amount of participation and the feasibility of operating a drop-off program. The program is being conducted on a voluntary basis for area residents. Residents of the City of Denison must have a copy of their current water bill and their driver licenses to show attendant. Non residents of the City of Denison must purchase a recycling coupon at the Water Office at 430 West Chestnut for \$1 per trip for 60 to 80 pounds of materials. Non residents must show their driver licenses and give the coupon to the attendant. At the end of the trial period, the Council will consider whether or not to continue the program, as well as any fees to help defray the cost of operations.

The identified drop-off location is the Residential Collection Station (RCS) located at 300 West FM 84, which is near the north end of Munson Park on US 69. The RCS is open 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on weekdays (except closed Wednesdays) and 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays.

The following instructions apply to recyclables that can be accepted and those that cannot:

ITEMS ACCEPTED

Plastic bottles and jugs
Clean paper and newspaper
Clean cardboard
Tin cans, including aerosol cans
Aluminum cans

NOT ACCEPTED

No plastic bags or Styrofoam products
No glass of any kind
No electronics
No paint cans or hazardous materials
No automotive parts

Notes:

1. All food containers need to be rinsed clean.
2. All paper and cardboard products need to be clean and dry.
3. Food-contaminated cardboard, such as pizza boxes, are NOT accepted.
4. Paper products include junk mail, phone books, catalogs and magazines.
5. Remove all tape and flatten all cardboard boxes to maximize shipping space.

CITY of DENISON RECYCLING PROGRAM

List of items that **CAN** be recycled:

Plastic: all bottles and jars (#1-7)

Tin Cans: Food and beverage cans that have been rinsed out

Aluminum Cans: Beverage cans that have been rinsed out and empty aerosol cans

Clean Paper: Newspaper, office paper, junk mail, phone books, catalogues and magazines. (Please have in a tied bundle or placed in a paper bags)

Cardboard Boxes: Corrugated cardboard, shipping boxes, shoe boxes, clean uncontaminated food boxes, etc.

Items that **CAN NOT** be recycled at this time:

NO plastic bags

NO glass

NO Styrofoam

NO Leaves or brush (At this location)

NO paint cans

NO automotive products

NO food

NO electronic/electrical products
