



What is the Adopt-an-Area Program?

AAAP is a volunteer program for litter prevention and control. It allows civic organizations, businesses, families, and individuals to adopt an area for the purpose of controlling and reducing litter.

What are the benefits?

- ❑ Reduces costs in dollars and manpower involved in the time-consuming operation of litter removal.
- ❑ Provides a way in which local citizens can demonstrate community pride.
- ❑ Demonstrates personal responsibility and changes attitudes regarding littering.
- ❑ Clean, attractive cities promote economic development.

How often must I pick up litter?

The AAAP requires that you make a commitment to adopt an area for 12 months and clean up at least 2 times. One of your cleanup events must coincide with **Texas Trash Off Day**.

What about cleanup supplies?

Participants in the AAAP may request supplies for a cleanup.

Supplies available for loan are:

- ✓ safety vests
- ✓ trash bags
- ✓ litter grabber sticks

How can I dispose of the litter collected?

You may call the City, during regular business hours, to pick up your filled trash bags. 903-464-4453 or dispose of your bags free of charge at the Residential Collection Station at 300 W. FM 84 in Denison.

Should I report my litter cleanup results?

Following a cleanup, it is very important to report your cleanup results to Keep Denison Beautiful. KDB maintains records on litter cleanups and reports the results to Keep Texas Beautiful and Keep America Beautiful.
