

# DENISON SKATEPARK

**PARK HOURS:  
DAYLIGHT TO SUNDOWN  
DURING BEGINNING TO END OF DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME**

## SKATEPARK RULES:

**The Park is CLOSED when the skate surface is wet or icy after hour use strictly prohibited. Children Under 12 Years of age must be accompanied by an adult.**

**By Using the City Of Denison Skatepark you agree to abide by the following rules:**

- 1. A helmet is required at all times while skating. Knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards are strongly recommended. Only one person per skateboard.**
- 2. Only skateboards and inline skates are allowed. No foot traffic, bicycles, scooters, roller skates, or quads, shoe skates, or motorized vehicles are allowed.**
- 3. No inverts, reckless, or out of control skating is permitted.**
- 4. No additional obstacles, materials, ramps or jumps may be brought into the skating area.**
- 5. The use of profane or abusive language or behavior is cause for removal from the skatepark.**
- 6. No horseplay, pranks, or fighting will be tolerated and is grounds for removal from the skatepark.**
- 7. No smoking, alcohol, or drugs is permitted in City of Denison Park facilities.**
- 8. No food, drinks, or glass containers are permitted on skating surface.**
- 9. No pets are allowed within the fenced area.**
- 10. Tagging or graffiti will result in closure of park**
- 11. Recurring violations will result in offenders being prohibited.**

**Spectators should watch from the spectator area outside the fence for safety.**

**Be respectful of other skaters and those using the surrounding park property and playground equipment.**

**Help control litter by using the receptacles provided.**
