

RESOLUTION NO. 4219

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENISON, TEXAS DESIGNATING AUTHORIZED SIGNATORIES FOR CONTRACTUAL AND FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND REVITALIZATION DIVISION RESILIENT COMMUNITIES PROGRAM GRANT AND CONTRACT NUMBER 23-160-065-E941; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Texas General Land Office (GLO) allocated up to \$100 million in Community Development Block Grant Mitigation funds for the Resilient Communities Program (RCP); and

WHEREAS, RCP will fund the development, update, adoption, and implementation of modern and resilient building codes, flood damage prevention ordinances, zoning ordinances, land use plans and/or comprehensive plans to ensure that structures built within the community can withstand future hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City of Denison, Texas (the "City") has received an RCP grant award (the "Grant") to provide for a comprehensive rewrite of building code regulations and a new Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint persons to execute contractual and financial documents pertaining to the Award from the Texas General Land Office Community Development and Revitalization (GLO-CDR) division; and

WHEREAS, all funds shall be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local, and programmatic requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DENISON, TEXAS, THAT:


Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The findings recited above are incorporated as if fully set forth in the body of this Resolution.

Section 2. Authorization to Act as Signatories on Contractual Documents. The Interim City Manager and Assistant City Manager of the City are hereby designated and authorized to act as signatories on all contractual documents pertaining to the Award, on behalf of the City.

Section 3. Authorization to Act as Signatories on Financial Documents. The Finance Director, Director of Development Services, Planning Manager and Chief Building Official of the City are hereby designated and authorized to act as signatories on all financial documents pertaining to the Award, on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
