PawPaw WWTP (UV Equipment & Primary Clarifier Improvements)

PROJECT OVERVIEW The PawPaw Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) has serviced the City of Denison for well over 50 years. The primary clarifier and ultraviolet (UV) treatment equipment have surpassed their useful life and need replacement. This project will consist of structural repairs to the clarifier to re-level the foundation and the sides of the tank. The UV equipment will be replaced to provide the disinfection required by State and Federal laws.
